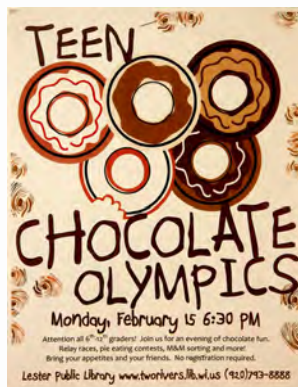

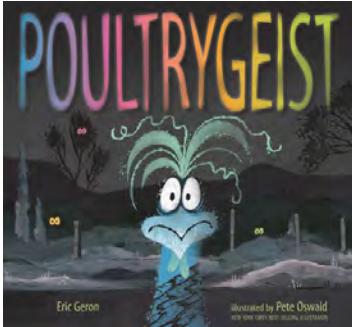
A SPOOKTACULAR DRIVE-THRU

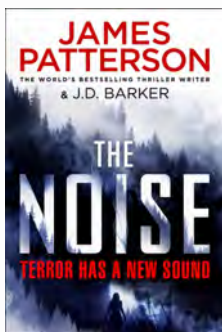
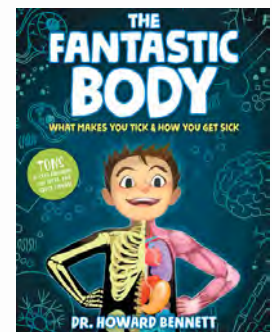

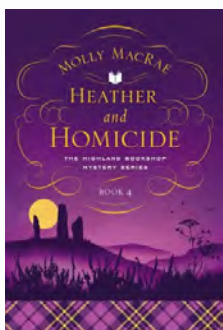
