Z. says: "It's good. I love the reading and logging minutes."

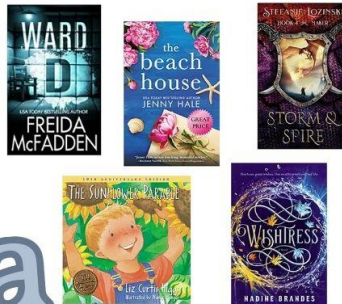

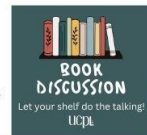
